Secure and well-lit free parking is available in the State of Connecticut lot at 107 Capitol Ave. and the Buckingham Garage at 315 Buckingham St. These locations are first-come, first-served and open 2 hours before each performance and closes 1 hour after. Accessible parking is available in both locations with a valid accessible parking permit. In addition, valet parking is available for most evening and weekend performances at a cost of \$15 per vehicle. Excludes weekday matinees.

Late Arrival

Late seating will be at the discretion of the production and requires that late patrons wait to enter the theater until a designated break in the performance. For your convenience, closed circuit televisions are in the lobbies.

In Case of an Emergency


Accessibility Information


